2. We must be Filled with the HOLY SPIRIT to fulfill God's Call on Our Life

Most of us know John 3:16 - Do we know Luke 3:16?

. Do I need to be filled with the Holy Spirit to go to Heaven?

The best scenario would be for a believer to be born again and Spirit-filled at the same time. Being filled with the Holy Spirit is not essential to be a Christian, but it was always expected by the apostles in the early Church.

>There are many references that show that people were believers but not filled with the Holy Spirit.

Acts 8:14-17 Acts 19:1-6 Acts 4:23-31

>Before Pentecost Jesus told the disciples not to continue ministry until they had been filled with the Holy Spirit Luke 24:49 Acts 1:4-5

>Jesus promised they would receive supernatural power from the Holy Spirit - Acts 1:8

Power Witness

>On Pentecost - ALL were filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke in tongues!!! Acts 2:4

- >The Good News is that this Holy Spirit power which was generally only upon the leadership in the Old Testament was now available to all believers Acts 2:17-20 Acts 2:38-39
- >1 Corinthians 12:8-10 lists 9 Manifestations/Gifts of the Holy Spirit. Can you name them?

Oral/Voice of God - Prophecy Tongues Interpretation of Tongues

Revelation/Mind of God - Discerning of Spirits Word of Wisdom Word of Knowledge

Power/Hand of God - Healing Miracles Faith

- >These Manifestations are God's POWER TOOLS to build the Kingdom!!!
- >Every Spirit-filled believer can be used in any and all of these 9 gifts. It is up to the Holy Spirit but also subject to the faith and availability of the believer.
- >The way we blow it is not to do it wrong but by not doing it at all
- >Your ministry as a Spirit-filled believer is no different than any other, non-Pentecostal believer, until you begin ministering in the Supernatural!!!
