

# Jesus Paid for Our Needs to Be Met

## The Principle of Reversal (9)

June 5, 2016

### #14. He suffered in public so that our private needs might be met.

Rom 3:24-25 ... by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus; 25 whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith ...

displayed = is "to place before, to set forth to be looked at, expose to public view." Vincent says, "Publicly, openly, correlated with to declare. He brought Him forth and put Him before the public." (from Wuest's Word Studies)

Gal 3:1 You foolish Galatians, who has bewitched you, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified?

Jesus was crucified at Calvary (on a hill) where everyone could see him;  
Mt 27:33; Mk 15:22; Lk 23:33; Jn 19:17

God asks us to deal privately with the faults (sins) of others.

Mt 18:15 "If your brother sins, go and show him his fault in private; if he listens to you, you have won your brother.

### #15. He was spit on to bear our degradation, dishonor, disgrace and putdowns.

#### Jesus was spit on:

**Jesus told His disciples that He was about to be killed and spit upon.**

Mk 10:32-34 ... "They will mock Him and spit on Him, and scourge Him and kill Him, and three days later He will rise again."

**This was in fulfillment of prophetic promise.**

Isa 50:6 I gave My back to those who strike Me, And My cheeks to those who pluck out the beard; I did not cover My face from humiliation and spitting.

**Jesus was spit upon at his trial.**

Mt 26:67-68 Then they spat in His face and beat Him with their fists; and others slapped Him, 68 and said, " Prophecy to us, You Christ; who is the one who hit You?" (Mk 14:65; 15:19)

#### Significance of being spat on:

**In both the OT and NT spitting is regarded as a sign of contempt** (Job 17:6; 30:10; Mk 10:34)

**Spitting on someone was part of a legal ritual of humiliation.**

Dt 25:9 then his brother's wife shall come to him in the sight of the elders, and pull his sandal off his foot and spit in his face; and she shall declare, 'Thus it is done to the man who does not build up his brother's house.'

Num 12:14 But the LORD said to Moses, "If her father had but spit in her face, would she not bear her shame for seven days?"

**Ritual uncleanness was conveyed by spitting.**

Lev 15:8 'Or if the man with the discharge spits on one who is clean, he too shall wash his clothes and bathe in water and be unclean until evening.

## **So that we could share in His glory.**

### **Prophetic promise:**

Isa 40:5 Then the glory of the LORD will be revealed, And all flesh will see it together;

Isa 55:5 "Behold, you will call a nation you do not know, and a nation which knows you not will run to you, Because of the LORD your God, even the Holy One of Israel; For He has glorified you."

Isa 60:1 "Arise, shine; for your light has come, And the glory of the LORD has risen upon you.

Isa 60:9 For the name of the LORD your God, and for the Holy One of Israel because He has glorified you.

### **Fulfilled in Christ:**

Jn 1:14 And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

2Cor 4:2 so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

2 Cor 4:6 For God, who said, "Light shall shine out of darkness," is the One who has shone in our hearts to give the Light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ.

Col 1:27 to whom God willed to make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

### **Given to believers in Christ:**

Jn 17:22 "The glory which You have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one, just as We are one;

Rom 8:17 and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him.

Rom 8:30 and these whom He predestined, He also called; and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also glorified.

Rom 9:23 And He did so to make known the riches of His glory upon vessels of mercy, which He prepared beforehand for glory, 24 even us, whom He also called, not from among Jews only, but also from among Gentiles.

2Cor 3:18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.

2Cor 4:17 For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison,

2 Tim 2:10 For this reason I endure all things for the sake of those who are chosen, so that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus and with it eternal glory.

1Pt 5:10 After you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will Himself perfect, confirm, strengthen and establish you.

1Thes 2:12 so that you would walk in a manner worthy of the God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.

## **So that we could share His honor.**

### **Prophetic promise:**

Zep 3:19-20 Behold, I am going to deal at that time with all your oppressors, I will save the lame and gather the outcast, and I will turn their shame into praise and renown in all the earth. 20 At that time I will bring you in, even at the time when I gather you together; Indeed, I will give you renown and praise among all the peoples of the earth, when I restore your fortunes before your eyes," says the LORD.

1Sam 2:30 ... for those who honor Me I will honor, ...

### **Fulfilled in Christ:**

Jn 12:26 "If anyone serves Me, he must follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also; if anyone serves Me, the Father will honor him."

## **#16. He rejected the sponge to quench His thirst and give Him deliverance from pain, so that we might be comforted in our pain.**

### **Prophetic promise:**

Isa 53:4 Surely our griefs He Himself bore, And our sorrows (pains) He carried; Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, Smitten of God, and afflicted.

Ps 69:21 They also gave me gall for my food and for my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.  
v. 26 For they have persecuted him whom You Yourself have smitten, and they tell of the pain of those whom You have wounded.

v. 29 But I am afflicted and in pain; May Your salvation, O God, set me securely on high.

### **Fulfilled in Christ:**

Mt 27:34 they gave Him wine to drink mixed with gall; and after tasting it, He was unwilling to drink.

Mt 4:24 The news about Him spread throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all who were ill, those suffering with various diseases and pains, demoniacs, epileptics, paralytics; and He healed them.

Rev 21:4 and He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away."

## **#17. He was sold to purchase our freedom.**

### **Before Christ, We were sold into sin.**

Rom 7:14 For we know that the Law is spiritual, but I am of flesh, sold into bondage to sin.

### **Example of Israel:**

Isa 52:3 For thus says the LORD, "You were sold for nothing and you will be redeemed without money" (Isa 50:3; 2Ki 17:17).

**Ahab sold himself to do evil** (1Ki 21:20, 25).

### **Prophetic promise, fulfilled in Christ**

Isa 35:9-10 No lion will be there, nor will any vicious beast go up on it; These will not be found there. But the redeemed will walk there, 10 And the ransomed of the LORD will return and come with joyful shouting to Zion, with everlasting joy upon their heads. They will find gladness and joy, and sorrow and sighing will flee away.

Isa 43:1 But now, thus says the LORD, your Creator, O Jacob, and He who formed you, O Israel, "Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name; you are Mine!

Isa 63:9 In all their affliction He was afflicted, and the angel of His presence saved them; in His love and in His mercy He redeemed them, and He lifted them and carried them all the days of old. (Isa 1:27; 44:22-23; 52:9; 62:12; Jer 31:11-14; Ps 119:9; 130:7)

## **Jesus, our Redeemer**

### **Was betrayed by Judas and sold for 30 silver pieces of silver.**

Mat 26:15 and said, "What are you willing to give me to betray Him to you?" And they weighed out thirty pieces of silver to him. (Zec 11:12-13; Mt 27:3-5)

### **He was sold - to purchase (redeem us) our freedom with His blood**

Mt 20:28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many." (Mk 10:45; Heb 9:12, 15; Rev 5:9)

Ac 20:28 "Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

Heb 9:11-12 But when Christ appeared as a high priest of the good things to come ... but through His own blood, He entered the holy place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. (Rev 5:9)

Rom 3:24 being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus; (1Cor 1:30; 6:20; 7:23; Gal 1:4; Eph 1:7; 5:2; Col 1:14, 20; 1Tim 2:6, 14; 1Pt 1:18-19)
