

We Are Redeemed, Sanctified Saints

The Principle of Reversal (10)

17. He was sold to purchase our freedom.

Mt 26:15 Judas was given 30 pieces of silver from the chief priests, to betray Jesus to them (Mt 27:3)

Sold, purchase = redemption!

Definitions: (from Dictionary of Bible Themes)

Redemption = The buying back or release of an object or person.

Ransom = The price paid for redemption, that is, for setting something or someone free from some form of obligation or captivity.

The death of Jesus Christ was a ransom for man.

1Tim 2:6 who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony given at the proper time
(Mk 10:45; Mt 20:28; Tit 2:14; Heb 9:15; 1Pt 1:18-19; 2Pt 2:1; Rev 5:9)

When a ransom was paid in the OT:

for every firstborn (Ex 13:13; 34:20; Nu 18:15)
for the first offspring of every beast (Ex 13:12-13; 34:20; Nu 18:14-17)
whenever a census was taken to number Israel (Ex 30:11-16; Nu 3:40-51)
when fulfilling a vow (Lev 27:1-33)
when your ox gores somebody (Ex 21:28-32)
to free someone from debt [slavery] (Lev 25:25-28; 47-55)
to free someone from widowhood (Ruth 4:1-13)

Jesus is our redemption

1Cor 1:30 But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption, (Tit 2:14)

Redemption comes through the blood of Jesus Christ

1Pt 1:18-19 knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, 19 but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ. (Ac 20:28; Rom 3:25; 1Cor 6:19-20; 7:23)

Heb 9:12 and not through the blood of goats and calves, but through His own blood, He entered the holy place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

Redemption results in:

Forgiveness of sin

Col 1:13-14 For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, 14 in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Justification

Rom 3:24 being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;
(Rom 3:28; 5:1-2, 9; 8:30; 1Cor 6:11; Gal 2:16; 3:11, 24; 5:4; Tit 3:7; Isa 45:25)

New Creation

2Cor 5:17 Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come. (Gal 6:15; Col 3:10; 2Cor 4:16-18; Eph 2:10; 3:16; 4:24)

Freedom to live a new life

Tit 2:14 who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.

Heb 9:14 how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?
(1Cor 6:19-20; 7:22-24; Col 1:13; Rev 1:5-6; 5:9-10)

Adoption as sons

Gal 4:5 so that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoption as sons. (Gal 4:4-7; Rom 8:15, 23; 9:4; Eph 1:5)

Free from the curse, and blessed

Gal 3:13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, "CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO HANGS ON A TREE"—

Inclusion in the covenant

Heb 9:15 For this reason He is the mediator of a new covenant, so that, since a death has taken place for the redemption of the transgressions that were committed under the first covenant, those who have been called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.
(Jer 31:31-34; Ezk 11:19 ; 36:26; Lk 22:20; 2Cor 3:6; Heb 8:8-12; 12:24; Gal 3:14)

18. He was counted among sinners so that God could count us as His own.

Jesus was counted (crucified with 2 thieves) with sinners so that we would be counted with all the saints.

Isa 53:12 ... And was numbered with the transgressors; ...

Mt 27:38 At that time two robbers were crucified with Him, one on the right and one on the left.
(Mt 27:44; Mk 15:27-28; Lk 22:37; 23:32-33,39-43; Jn 19:18,31-35)

Through Christ we are saints.

Col 1:12 who (the Father) has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in Light.
(Rom 1:7; 1Cor 1:2; 14:33; 2Cor 1:1; Eph 2:19; 4:12; Phil 1:1; Col 1:2, 26; Jude 3)

We are holy (sanctified).

Heb 10:10 By this will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

Heb 10:14 For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified
(1Cor 1:2; 6:11; Heb 2:11; 10:29; 13:12; Eph 5:26; 1Thes 5:23)

We are blameless.

Eph 5:27 that He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless.
(Eph 1:4; 5:25-27; Col 1:22, 28; 1Thes 5:23)

19. Jesus experienced mental agony so that we could be healed from all mental torment.

Jesus experienced mental agony in the Garden of Gethsemane

Lk 22:42-44 saying, "Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me; yet not My will, but Yours be done." 43 Now an angel from heaven appeared to Him, strengthening Him. 44 And being in agony He was praying very fervently; and His sweat became like drops of blood, falling down upon the ground.

Mt 26:38 Then He said to them, " My soul is deeply grieved, to the point of death; remain here and keep watch with Me." (Mt 26:36-46)

Mk 14:33-34 And He took with Him Peter and James and John, and began to be very distressed and troubled. 34 And He said to them, "My soul is deeply grieved to the point of death; remain here and keep watch." (Mk 14:32-42)

Jesus healed a tormented man with a legion of demons (Lk 8:26-39)

Lk 8:35 The people went out to see what had happened; and they came to Jesus, and found the man from whom the demons had gone out, sitting down at the feet of Jesus, clothed and in his right mind; and they became frightened. (Mk 5:15)

Promise of a healthy mind:

New Covenant

Heb 8:10 "FOR THIS IS THE COVENANT THAT I WILL MAKE ... I WILL PUT MY LAWS INTO THEIR MINDS, AND I WILL WRITE THEM ON THEIR HEARTS ...(Heb 10:16; Jer 31:33)

1Cor 2:16 ... But we have the mind of Christ.

2Tim 1:7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power, love and of a sound mind

Our mind needs renewal

Eph 4:23 ... be renewed in the spirit of your mind, (Rom 12:2; Col 3:10; 2Cor 4:16)

Results in peace of mind

Isa 26:3 "The steadfast of mind You will keep in perfect peace,

Phil 4:7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
