

# Resurrection, Joy and Healing

## The Principle of Reversal (12)

June 26, 2016

### 23. He submitted to death to deliver us from death's power.

Heb 2:14-15 Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, 15 and might free those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives.

#### Jesus:

##### Jesus submitted to death

Phil 2:8 Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

##### Jesus laid down (gave up) His life for us.

Jn 10:18 "No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down on My own initiative. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. (Jn 10:15-18; 15:13)

Gal 2:20 ... Who loved me and gave Himself up for me. (Gal 1:3-4; Eph 5:2, 25; 1Tim 2:6; Tit 2:14)

##### Jesus broke the power of death

Ps 68:20-21 ... And to GOD the Lord belong escapes from death. 21 Surely God will shatter the head of His enemies, ...

2 Tim 1:10 ... by the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel,

Rom 5:17 For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.

Heb 2:9 ... namely, Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone.

Rev 1:18 (I am) the living One; and I was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of death and of Hades.

1 Cor 15:26 The last enemy that will be abolished is death.  
(1Cor 15:24-26, 54-55; Hos 13:14; Heb 2:14-15; Rev 20:13-14; 21:4; Isa 25:8)

#### Resurrection:

##### To be with Jesus Christ when our body dies.

2 Co 5:8 ... to be absent from the body and at home with the Lord ...  
(2 Co 5:1-9; Lk 23:43; Jn 11:25-26)

##### Resurrection is promised by Jesus to believers.

Jn 11:25-26 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, 26 and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die."  
(Jn 5:28-29; 6:39-40; 14: 3; Mt 24:31; Mk 13:27)

### **Bodily resurrection OT promises**

Isa 26:19 Your dead will live; their corpses will rise. you who lie in the dust, awake and shout for joy, for your dew is as the dew of the dawn, and the earth will give birth to the departed spirits.  
(Isa 25:7-8; Hos 6:2; 13:14; Ps 17:15; Ps 73:24)

### **Bodily resurrection NT promises**

1Cor 15:20-21 But now Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who are asleep. 21 For since by a man came death, by a man also came the resurrection of the dead  
(1Cor 15:22-23; 43-44; 48-49)

1Cor 6:14 Now God has not only raised the Lord, but will also raise us up through His power.  
(2Cor 4:14; Phil 3:21; Col 3:4; 1Thes 4:13-17; 2Thes 2:1-2; Jude 24)

### **Power over the devil:**

Heb 2:14 ... that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, (2 Thes 3:3; 1Jn 4:4; 5:18;

1 Jn 3:8 ... The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil.

Col 2:15 When He had disarmed the rulers and authorities, He made a public display of them, having triumphed over them through Him. (Eph 1:19-21; 2 Cor 10:4)

## **24. He carried our grief so the grieving might receive joy.**

Isa 53:4 Surely our griefs He Himself bore, And our sorrows He carried; ...

### **Prophetic fulfillment through Jesus Christ**

Isa 52:9 Break forth, shout joyfully together, You waste places of Jerusalem; For the LORD has comforted His people, He has redeemed Jerusalem. (Isa 35:10; 44:23; 49:13; 51:11; 54:1; 55:12)

Isa 61:3 To grant those who mourn in Zion, Giving them a garland instead of ashes, The oil of gladness instead of mourning, The mantle of praise instead of a spirit of fainting ...

### **Joy promises**

Ps 4:7 You have put gladness in my heart, more than when their grain and new wine abound.  
(Ps 30:11-12; 126:5-6; Neh 8:10)

### **Sources of joy:**

#### **Jesus**

1Pt 1:8 and though you have not seen Him, you love Him, and though you do not see Him now, but believe in Him, you greatly rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory,  
(Jn 15:11; 16:22; 17:13)

#### **The Holy Spirit**

Ac 13:52 And the disciples were continually filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.  
(Ac 2:28; Rom 14:17; 15:13; Gal 5:22)

#### **The presence of God**

Ps 16:11 ... In Your presence is fullness of joy; in Your right hand there are pleasures forever.

Ps 21:6 For ... You make him joyful with gladness in Your presence.

1 Chron 16:27 Splendor and majesty are before Him, strength and joy are in His place.

#### **Answered prayer**

Jn 16:24 "Until now you have asked for nothing in My name; ask and you will receive, so that your joy may be made full.

## **25. His body was torn so that are torn bodies might be healed.**

Isa 53:5 But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed.

### **Promise of healing under the Law**

Ex 15:26 And He said, "If you will give earnest heed to the voice of the LORD your God, and do what is right in His sight, and give ear to His commandments, and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have put on the Egyptians; for I, the LORD, am your healer."  
(Ex 23:25; Dt 7:15; 32:39; 2Chr 7:14; Job 5:18; Ps 6:2; 30:2; 41:3-4; Pr 3:7-8; Jer 3:22; 17:14)

### **He forgives our sins and heals our diseases**

Ps 103:3 Who pardons all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases;  
(Mk 2:1-12; Mt 9:2-8; Lk 5:17-26)

### **By His wounds we [were, are, will be] healed (past present, future).**

1Pt 2:24 He bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that ... By His wounds you were healed.

Isa 53:5 ... And by His scourging we are healed.

Jas 5:16 ... so that you may (will) be healed ...

### **Jesus fulfills the healing prophecy of Isaiah**

Mt 8:16-17 When evening came, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed; and He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were ill. 17 This was to fulfill what was spoken through Isaiah the prophet: "HE HIMSELF TOOK OUR INFIRMITIES AND CARRIED AWAY OUR DISEASES."

### **Jesus healed all who came to Him**

Ac 10:38 "You know of Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and how He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him. (Lk 4:18; Mt 11:5)

Mt 4:23 Jesus was going throughout all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness among the people. (Mt 9:35)

Mt 12:15 Jesus, aware of this, withdrew from there. Many followed Him, and He healed them all,

Mt 8:7-8 Jesus said to him, "I will come and heal him." 8 But the centurion said, "Lord, I am not worthy for You to come under my roof, but just say the word, and my servant will be healed."  
(Mt 8:5-13; Lk 7:2-10)

Lk 6:7-11 The scribes and the Pharisees were watching Him closely to see if He healed on the Sabbath, ... 10 After looking around at them all, He said to him, "Stretch out your hand!" And he did so; and his hand was restored.

Mt 14:14 He saw a large crowd, and felt compassion for them and healed their sick.  
(Mt 15:30; 19:2; 21:14; Lk 5:15; 9:11)

Mk 1:34 And He healed many who were ill with various diseases, (Mk 3:10; Lk 6:18-19)

Mk 6:5 And He could do no miracle there except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them.

Lk 4:40 While the sun was setting, all those who had any who were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and laying His hands on each one of them, He was healing them.

Lk 5:17 One day He was teaching; and there were some Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting there, who had come from every village of Galilee and Judea and from Jerusalem; and the power of the Lord was present for Him to perform healing. (Lk 5:17-26)

### **Prophetic promise of healing**

Isa 57:18-19 "I have seen his ways, but I will heal him; I will lead him and restore comfort to him and to his mourners, 19 Creating the praise of the lips. Peace, peace to him who is far and to him who is near," Says the LORD, "and I will heal him."

Isa 61:1 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me, to bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to captives and freedom to prisoners

Ps 107:20 He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.  
(Ps 147:3; Isa 33:24; Jer 30:17; 33:6-8; Hos 6:1-2; 14:4; Mal 4:2)

Rev 22:2 ... On either side of the river was the tree of life, ... the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. (Ezek 47:12)

### **Jesus gave authority to heal**

Mt 10:1 Jesus summoned His twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal every kind of disease and every kind of sickness. (Lk 9:1-2; 10:9; Mt 10:8)

Lk 9:6 Departing, they began going throughout the villages, preaching the gospel and healing everywhere. (Mk 6:13)

1 Cor 12:9 to another faith by the same Spirit, and to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit,

### **Healing in Acts**

Ac 4:30 while You extend Your hand to heal, and signs and wonders take place through the name of Your holy servant Jesus." (Ac 5:16; 8:7)

### **God desires to heal; our (man's) part is repentance**

Isa 6:8-10 Then I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I. Send me!" 9 He said, "Go, and tell this people: 'Keep on listening, but do not perceive; Keep on looking, but do not understand.' 10 " Render the hearts of this people insensitive, Their ears dull, And their eyes dim, Otherwise they might see with their eyes, Hear with their ears, Understand with their hearts, And return and be healed ."

(Mt 13:15; Jn 12:36-41; Ac 28:23-29)
