## I. God Is Faithful

**He called you, and will also do it.**

1 Thes 5:24 Faithful is He who calls you, and He also will bring it to pass.

**He who started a good work in you will complete it.**

Phil 1:6 For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.

**The end of a thing is greater than the beginning**

Ecc 7:8 The end of a matter is better than its beginning;

**He is the Author and Finisher of your faith.**

Heb 12:2 fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith,

**He is a sun and shield, He will give grace and glory.**

Ps 84:11 For the LORD God is a sun and shield; the Lord gives grace and glory;

No good thing will He withhold from you.

Ps 84:11 No good thing does He withhold from those who walk uprightly.

## II. Nothing is impossible with God.

**His grace is greater than our weakness.**

2 Cor 12:9 "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness."

**His healing is greater than our sickness.**

1 Peter 2:24 ...for by His wounds you were healed .

**His purpose is more powerful than persecution. His love is greater than all the things of this life that try to separate us from it.**

Rom 8:35 Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

Rom 8:37-39 But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us. 38 For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, 39 nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**His power is greater than Satan's devices.**

Eph 6:11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil

2 Cor 2:11 so that no advantage would be taken of us by Satan, for we are not ignorant of his schemes .

### **III. Nothing is impossible for us.**

#### **Our God will fight for us.**

Zeph 3:17 "The LORD your God is in your midst, A victorious warrior . He will exult over you with joy, He will be quiet in His love, He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy. (Ex 15:3; Judg 6:12; Ps 78:65; Isa 42:13)

#### **The battle is not ours but God's.**

2 Chron 20:15 ...the battle is not yours but God's. (1 Sam 17:47; Ps 55:18)

#### **We are more than conquerors**

2 Cor 2:14 But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumph in Christ,

1 Cor 15:57 but thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

**He that is in us is greater than he that is in the world** (1 John 4:4).

**The God of peace will soon crush Satan underneath our feet** (Rom 16:20).

#### **He will arise and scatter our enemies.**

Ps 68:1 Let God arise , let His enemies be scattered,

Ps 21:8 Your hand will find out all your enemies; Your right hand will find out those who hate you.

Ps 27:3 Though a host encamp against me, My heart will not fear; Though war arise against me, In spite of this I shall be confident.

**No weapon formed against us to prosper** (Isa 54:17).

**We can do all things through Christ who strengthens us** (Phil 4:13).

### **IV. His grace is sufficient for us.**

#### **Even when we are weak we are strong, for the power of Christ rest upon us.**

2 Cor 12:8-10 Concerning this I implored the Lord three times that it might leave me. 9 And He has said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness." Most gladly, therefore, I will rather boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me. 10 Therefore I am well content with weaknesses, with insults, with distresses, with persecutions, with difficulties, for Christ's sake; for when I am weak, then I am strong.

#### **Your latter will be greater; your best days are ahead.**

Hag 2:9 'The latter glory of this house will be greater than the former,' says the LORD of hosts, 'and in this place I will give peace,' declares the LORD of hosts."

#### **You haven't seen anything yet.**

1 Cor 2:9 but just as it is written, "THINGS WHICH EYE HAS NOT SEEN AND EAR HAS NOT HEARD, AND WHICH HAVE NOT ENTERED THE HEART OF MAN, ALL THAT GOD HAS PREPARED FOR THOSE WHO LOVE HIM."
